ATTENTION ! ALL BULK CONSUMERS OF ELECTRIC & ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENTS

Central/State Govt. Deptts./PSU'S/Banks/Educational institutions/ Multinational Organisations/ International agencies/Public/Pvt. Companies and Health Care Facilities having turnover>1Crore or having more than 20 employees.



- The E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 is applicable to every manufacturer, producer, consumer, bulk consumer, collection center, dealer, e-retailer, refurbisher, dismantler, recycler involved in manufacture, sale, purchase and processing of electrical and electronic equipments (EEE) as listed in Schedule–I including their components, etc.
- Under section 9 of the said Rules, it is obligatory on the part of bulk consumers of EEE listed in Schedule- I to ensure that
 - i. E-waste generated by them is channelized through collection centers or dealers of registered producers, dismantlers or recyclers or through the designated take back service providers of the producers;
 - ii. Records of e-waste generated are maintained in Form-2 and are made available for scrutiny to State Pollution Control Board;
 - iii.**Annual return** in Form-3 is submitted to the Board on or before 30th June, for each financial year.

Failure to comply with above obligations is punishable offence under section 15 of E (P) Act, 1986.
