Sub: Installation of Effluent Treatment Plant

(415 33 A of the Water Act)

Sir,

This has reference to the Board's afore-referred direction, followed by a reminder whereby you were directed to install proper Effluent Treatment Plant before processing and producing parboiled rice (usna rice), but, till date, no reply has been received by the Board.

It may be worth reminder that during inspection of your unit on 23.04.2018, there was Effluent Treatment Plant in damaged state and not worth operation. It was also felt and communicated to you during inspection and thereafter by aforesaid communication from the Board that you cannot operate your industrial plant for processing parboiled rice (usna rice) without equipping yourself with a proper and adequate Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP). But, apparently, due to wilful negligence, communication gap has been created and the Board is ignorant about development thereafter with respect to installation of ETP in your unit.

It is assumed that you are still not operating your plant for producing rice, as you might not have installed ETP for the said purpose. With this understanding, the Board warns you to come in operation only when ETP is installed and before such installation this Board has been informed, so that a proper inspection could be conducted and you are formally allowed to proceed for processing parboiled rice (usna rice) in your unit.

In the event of failure to respond to this letter, this Board will have reason to believe that you are bent upon to violate willingly the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and therefore, complaint u/s 44 of the said Act shall be filed before the competent court of law.


