This letter serves to formally communicate the decision of the Board regarding the blacklisting and debarment of M/s Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd., 6-3-1089/4/4, Ground Floor, Opp. Yes Bank, Raj Bhawan Road, Somajiguda, Hyderabad-500082 from participating in or entering into any tender or contract with any Government Organization for a period of 02 years from the date of issuance of this communication.

The decision to blacklist and debar your company was taken by the Board on 12.05.2026 after personal hearing conducted by the Board to give an opportunity to hear in the instance matter. The Board also perused your submissions dated-30.12.2025 & 25.03.2026 against the show cause notice issued by the Board vide ref. no. CL/57, dated-19.03.2026 and found unsatisfactory. The withdrawal of bid after opening of financial bid and identified as L1 bidder was intentionally for delay the tender process.


During the period of debarment, M/s Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd., 6-3-1089/4/4, Ground Floor, Opp. Yes Bank, Raj Bhawan Road,

Somajiguda, Hyderabad-500082 will not eligible to participate in any new tender process, submit bids or enter into any form of contractual agreement with any Government Organization. Please take note of this order and ensure compliance.

ORDER

12.05.2026

The Central Government with a view to improve the collection, segregation, processing, treatment and disposal of the Bio-Medical waste in an environmentally sound manner made the Bio-Medical Waste Management, Rules, 2016, (for short BMW, Rules) in exercise of the powers under Section 6, 8 & 25 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Rule 7 of the BMW, Rules provides that the bio-medical waste shall be treated and disposed and disposed by a Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment facility (CBWTF).

Bihar State Pollution Control Board (State Board) in discharge of its duties and functions under the BMW Rules, 2016, as amended and Guidelines for Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facilities issued by CPCB, invited bids from competent and eligible Company/Society/Trust firm/Partnership firm/Proprietorship firm for the purpose of setting up and operating a Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment facility (CBWTF) at Madhubani, vide E-tender No. CL/1655/23-84, dated 11.07.2025 and vide E-tender No. CL/1654/2023-94, dated 05.08.2025 for Muzaffarpur.

The schedule of the tender/bidding was provided in the tender notice and the date of opening of technical bid was fixed on 19.08.2025 for Madhubani and 03.10.2025 for Muzaffarpur, further in the tender notice under Paragraph no.

5 it was categorically mentioned that the tender process shall remain subject to the outcome of the SLP No. 16284 of 2025 pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. submitted bids under the said tenders and was found to be technically qualified and further the bids submitted by M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd., was found to be lowest and accordingly M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd., was selected as L1 for both the location, i.e., Madhubani and Muzaffarpur on 17.12.2025. At the outset it is stated that the financial bids submitted by M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd., was very low and practically impossible.

M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd., all of a sudden, after being decaled as L1, vide its letter dated 30.12.2025 withdrew the bids from the tender submitted to the State Board. As a result of such withdrawal, the entire tender process with respect to the aforesaid two locations got stalled and ultimately led to cancellation of the tender and issuance of fresh tenders. It was carried out by the company with malicious intent to disrupt the tender process and favour the existing service providers.

The State Board vide its letter no. CL/57, dated 19.03.2026 issued a show-cause notice to M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. to file its reply against the proposed action of blacklisting and recommending cancellation of Udyam Registration Certificate.

M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. replied to the show cause notice vide its letter dated 25.03.2026 and stated, inter-alia, that since the LOA was not issued in favour of them therefore no contract was entered between the State Board and M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. and therefore the question of blacklisting does not arise and further it has been stated that blacklisting is a last resort remedy applicable in cases where damages have been caused after award and failure on part of execution.

The State Board vide its letter No. CL/79, dated 04.05.2026, directed the unit to appear for personal hearing on 12.05.2026. On 12.05.2026 representatives of M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. appeared along with an Advocate and opposed the blacklisting. It was stated in the hearing that bids were withdrawn at a very early stage and at the time of withdrawal of bids no contract was entered between the State Board and M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. and as such no financial loss has been caused and further the terms of the tender does not prescribe for blacklisting and without express provision of blacklisting, the State Board does not have the jurisdiction to pass an order of blacklisting.

The Learned Advocate of the State Board submitted that the tenders were in respect to establishment of CBWTF, which is a very essential service and the State Board being the competent authority has been trying to take necessary steps for the establishment of the same. Initial tenders were invited by the State Board vide NIT No. CL/884/2022/210, dated 22.12.2022 in the year 2022 and due to cancellation of the same, writ petitions were filed before the Hon'ble Patna High Court, and the said writ petitions came to be dismissed vide order dated 07.05.2025. Thereafter, SLP was preferred before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, which was dismissed vide order dated 25.02.2026. Therefore, from the above stated facts it can be seen that the entire process of setting up CBWTF has got delayed due to cancellation of tenders and subsequent litigation. Further, the instant tender process has now been halted due to untimely withdrawal of the bids by M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. and the State Board. It is submitted by the learned Advocate that the entire scheme appears to be a plot to delay the tender process and to create an atmosphere so that tenders do not get finalized so that the company presently carrying the CBWTF continue to operate their CBWTFs. Further it has been submitted by the

learned counsel that the rates quoted by M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. is very low and impractical and company participating in tender can submit such low rate and low rates were submitted with mala fide intention to become L1 and later on withdraw from the tenders, so that the tender process gets stalled. The average rate quoted by L1 M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. is Rs. 32.73/- whereas the rate quoted by L2 is Rs. 117.7/- for Madhubani and average rate quoted by L1 M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. is Rs. 32.73/- whereas rate quoted by L2 is Rs. 94.18/- for Muzaffarpur, therefore it is evident that the very low rate was quoted as M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. was prepared to withdraw from the tender process at a later stage.

A comparison of the amount quoted by M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd clearly indicates the company's mala fide intent, as reflected in the table below. The quoted amount is unrealistically low and appears to have been submitted with the intention of vitiating the tender process.

Heard the parties and pursued the records, from the records it appears that the M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. participated in the tender, was found to be technically qualified and later on found to be lowest bidder and accordingly declared L1 for two locations Madhubani and Muzaffarpur. However, at a very advanced stage prior to issuance of LOA it withdrew its bids from the tender for the reason that there is no clarity with respect to matter being disposed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP No. 16248 of 2025. From the tender notice it is clear that a categorical clause was incorporated in the tender document wherein it was mentioned that the tender is subject to outcome of SLP No. 16248 of 2025, therefore the grounds of no clarity is not well established and it appears that it has been causally taken to withdraw from the tender process.

Further, as pointed out by the counsel of the State Board, that the rates quoted by M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. is very low and impractical and from which it appears that the low rates were quoted to ensure that no other entity becomes L1 so that they can withdraw bids at a later stage and fail the tender process. From the arguments advanced and the records of the case the undersigned has no hesitation in holding that the M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd. has the intention to withdraw from the tender from the

very beginning and it participated in tender with a sole purpose of frustrating the same.

It is to be borne in mind that the tenders were in relation to establishment of CBWTF, which is a very essential service and deals with treatment and disposal of the bio-medical waste and to delay such tenders by intentionally withdrawing from tender at advanced stage by taking a flimsy ground of clarity of disposal of matter by the Hon'ble Supreme Court must be dealt with severity.

Accordingly, M/S Sattva Global Services Pvt. Ltd., 6-3-1089/4/4, Ground Floor, Opp. Yes Bank, Raj Bhawan Road, Somajiguda, Hyderabad-500082, is hereby blacklisted for a period of two years and debarred from participating in or entering into any tender contract for two years from the date of issuance of this order.

Further, it is recommended that a proposal be sent to the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises for cancellation of the company's Udyam Registration Certificate, as the company has allegedly misused the privileges extended to MSME entities. The company shall also be liable to pay an amount equivalent to the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), at par with the requirement applicable to non-MSME companies.
