

**Minutes of Public Hearing of proposed highway Sasaram to Patna in the State of Biha under Bharatmala Pariyojna (lot-7, Package-2) for length in District-Patna.**

This public hearing was organized by the Bihar State Pollution Control Board, Patna and presided by the ADM, Patna under the provisions of EIA, 2006. Notice of public hearing had been published in daily news papers-*The Times of India, Saturday, October 1, 2022; Hindustan Times, Patna, Saturday, October 1, 2022 and Prabhat Khabar, Patna, October 1, 2022.* Alongside, announcement with amplifier had also been done by the applicant prior the hearing in concern villages for the publicity of the public hearing to ensure maximum participation of the public concerned.

Sri Anil Kumar, Regional Officer, BSPCB, Patna welcome the ADM, Patna, representatives of local public representatives, project proponent, public and other participants in the public hearing and initiated with introduction about the project. He informed the importance of public hearing for Environmental Clearance of the proposed project in such a rural area and its benefits to the local people.

Sri Amitav Sinha, ADM, Patna welcome the representatives of the project proponent, public and other participants present during the public hearing. He initiated with introduction about the road development project and given a brief introduction about the project. Explained about how the area of the proposed project will be developed with increase in land value. He said that if you have any suggestions and questions related to this project, then you can ask.

Shri Rajesh Kumar Vishwas, EIA Consultant of the project explained the project details and highlighted the following:-

- He explained that this is highway road project under the Bharatmala project of our country and will pass through State Bihar. He said that the proposed highway along with spur road starts from village Gangauli 24°55'13.21"N 84°8'23.72"E and ends at village Dhanupara 25°35'2.82"N 84°43'5.09"E in Rohtas and Bhojpur district in the state of Bihar. Total length 84 Km with Spur road of 11.8 km. Scope of present report is confined to (Ch. 0+000 to Ch. 84+000) for highway & (Ch. 0+000 to Ch. 11+800) for spur road. The proposed By-pass (Ara-Patna ring road) starts at village Madhopur 25°33'1.80"N/84°55'34.53"E and end at village Garha 25°31'44.81"N/84°36'4.89"E of Patna and Bhojpur district respectively in the state of Bihar. Scope of present report is confined from Ch. 0+000 to Ch. 35+000). Project Highway Alignment (Greenfield) length is 84 km and proposed RoW is 45 m with spur road (Kayampur Spur) of 11.8 km By-pass Road/Ring Road (Arrah by-pass) of 35 km and proposed RoW is 60 m. This is a green field alignment and is proposed for 4-Lane.
- This highway proposed to pass through 02 Tehsils (Naubatpur & Bihta) and approx 21 villages of District Patna in the state of Bihar. The total length of the (Patna Ring Road) highway is approx. 18.0 km in District Patna. Described about the project salient features, baseline environmental data & conditions.
- Proposed expressway does not pass through forest land or Eco sensitive zone as notified by the MoEFCC, Govt, of India. The propose highway will provide connectivity among remote villages of the area. For better connectivity and movement of local traffic in the project area appropriate number of structures (minor bridges, vehicular underpasses, etc) will be constructed. Cross drainage structures (Bridges & Culverts) at appropriate locations will be constructed for free flow of irrigation water through canal, if any involve and water during rainy season.
- Tree plantation is proposed along both side of the highway. Project will ensure water sprinkling during construction period to suppress fugitive emission, compliance of the provisions of the Solid Waste Management, 2016 as well as the Noise Rules, 2000.





The proceedings of the public hearing are recorded and video taken. The same shall be submitted to all concern and the authority for necessary action.
