

## **Important Notice**

### **Disposal of Application time-frame – for- Consent within a statutory**

This is for the information to any person, including industrialists and entrepreneurs, having applied for Consent under the provisions of section 25 of the water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 that:

- i. The Consent referred to in sub-section(1) of section 25 of the water(Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 shall ,unless given or refused earlier, be deemed to have been given unconditionally under section 25(7) of the said Act on the expiry of a period of 4 month of the making of an application in this behalf complete in all respects to the State Board;

AND

- ii. within a period of 4 months after the receipt of the Application- for- Consent referred to in sub-section (1) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 the State Board under section 21(4) of the said Act shall, by order in writing and for reasons to be recorded in order, grant the consent applied for subject to such conditions and for such period as may be specified in the order, or refuse consent.
